### **ELECTORAL ROLL**

Every six years the Electoral Roll of all churches in the Diocese have to be revised and 2019 is the year. It has to be completed before the end of March. Forms are available in the bookshelf at the back of the church. I need a separate form for each person who wishes to be on the roll and young people who are going to attain the age of sixteen after 7th April should also complete a form. Being on the Electoral roll entitles you to vote at the APCM, to be a member of the PCC, to be a Sidesman, Server or Reader. It also means that if you have been missing from the congregation for a week or two and need our help, we know where to find you. After the APCM on 7th April, the old roll will no longer apply so if you do not complete a new form you will not be on the roll.
